

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Succulent	Aloe Variegata
Description:	Striking evergreen succulent with decorative variegated white and green coloured foliage. Aloes are some of the hardiest plants available to Australian gardeners. Great accent plant in garden or tub.
Planting Position:	Requires a very well drained soil and a full sun position. They are ideal for use in large tubs, arid garden beds, dry rock embankments, perfectly at home in cottage gardens. Temperature Range: 8° to 40°
Plant Size (approx):	30cm high x 30cm wide
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize with a good quality liquid plant food two or three times a year. Will tolerate short periods of dryness. Water only when dry.
