| <b>Description:</b>                | A small upright evergreen shrub with long narrow, aromatic leaves and masses of large purple-pink bell shaped flowers from August to November.                                                                                                                          |
| <b>Planting Position:</b>          | Ideal for garden beds, native gardens and as a bird attracting shrub. Prefers to grow amongst other plants. Best suited to an open, well drained slightly acid soil. Lightly prune after flowering to keep bushy and prolong plant life.<br>Temperature Range 7° to 37° |
| <b>Plant Size (approx):</b>        | 1 - 2.5m high x 50 -75cm wide                                                                                                                                                                                                                                           |
| <b>Planting:</b>                   | Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.                                                  |
