

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Cordyline	Cordyline Cha Cha (Cordyline australis)
Description:	New variety with colourful weeping variegated foliage. The young strap like leaves are a warm blend of apricot and brown, changing as the leaves mature to a striking mix of yellow and green. Ever changing colour of the foliage year round is unique to Cha Cha.
Planting Position:	Plant in full sun or part shaded area in well drained soil. Excellent for mass display in garden or as a feature in a tub. Temperature Range 1° to 40 °
Plant Size (approx):	2m high x 1.5m wide.
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
