

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Cordyline	Cordyline Kiwi (<i>Cordyline fruticosa</i>)
Description:	An attractive plant with an upright stalk of green and crimson foliage. Provides a magnificent kaleidoscope of colour and a tropical feel to the garden or patio.
Planting Position:	Can be kept in pots as a display for the patio or planted in a part shade protected area in the garden. Will tolerate some sun once established. Temperature Range: 5° to 35°
Plant Size (approx):	60cm -1m high x 60cm - 1m wide.
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
