

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Fern	Davallia Fejeensis (Hares Foot Fern)
Description:	A good fern for shaded, protected positions in the garden or bush-house. An excellent specimen basket plant. The fronds are very finely-dissected with a weeping habit and are very good for floral work.
Planting Position:	Can be kept in pots as a display for the patio or planted in a protected area in the garden. Best if given some protection from frost. Never allow to dry out. Ph between 5 and 6.5 for best results. Temperature Range 2° to 40°
Plant Size (approx):	0.6m high x 0.6m wide
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
