

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Escallonia	Escallonia Pink Pixi (Exoniensis fradesii nana)
Description:	Compact dwarf Escallonia with vibrant glossy leaves with a brilliant display of pink bell shaped flowers from spring to late summer. Fast growing.
Planting Position:	Great addition to any garden, as a hedge, or in a rockery. Grows in full sun or part shade and suitable for coastal conditions. Thrives in moist well drained soil. Temperature Range 7° to 37°
Plant Size (approx):	80cm high x 80cm wide
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
