

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Ficus	Climbing Fig (Ficus Pumila)
Description:	Evergreen climber with small, bright green, heart shaped leaves when young. Leaves turn leathery and become oval in shape when plants mature. An excellent self clinging climber for walls, brickwork and fences.
Planting Position:	Grows in a sunny to partly shaded position in moist, well drained soil or free draining potting mix. Excellent for hanging baskets. Temperature Range 0°C to 40°C
Plant Size (approx):	Spreading or climbing 1m x 1m
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
