

## PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

<b>Product Group:</b> Grewia	<b>Grewia occidentalis Lavender Star</b>
<b>Description:</b>	Attractive shrub or small tree bearing purple or mauve star like flowers in summer. Flowers are followed by distinctive four lobed fruit. Young plants can be trained into good bonsai specimens.
<b>Planting Position:</b>	Ideal in garden beds, borders and even hedged. Can also be grown in large tubs. Grows in full sun or part shade in moist, well drained soil. Temperature Range: 2°C to 40°C
<b>Plant Size (approx):</b>	1.5 – 3m high x 1 – 2m wide
<b>Planting:</b>	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
<b>Fertilizing &amp; Watering:</b>	Fertilize with a good quality liquid plant food two or three times a year. Will tolerate short periods of dryness. Water only when dry.
