

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Lavender	Lavender Frenchette (Lavandula Dentata)
Description:	Compact form of French lavender with aromatic grey-green foliage and beautiful spikes of lavender blue flowers. A flush of flowers appear in late winter and spot flowers occur throughout the year.
Planting Position:	Great addition to gardens as mass plantings, hedges, borders or grown in pots. Best grown in full sun. Tolerant of frost and dry conditions once established. Prefers moist and well drained soil. Temperature Range: 2° to 35°
Plant Size (approx):	1m high x 1m wide
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
