| <b>Product Group: Fern</b>         | <b>Rumorha Adiantiformis (Leather Fern)</b>   |
| <b>Description:</b>                | A fern suitable for bush-house or shade position. It is particularly suitable to temperate regions and is frost tolerant. Known world-wide for its cut foliage. Slender, scaly, long, creeping rhizomes with leathery fronds. Very hardy and easy to grow in most situations. |
| <b>Planting Position:</b>          | Can be kept in pots as a display for the patio or planted in a protected area in the garden. Best if given some protection from frost. Never allow to dry out. Ph between 5 and 6.5 for best results.<br><br>Temperature Range 1° to 40°                                      |
| <b>Plant Size (approx):</b>        | 40cm to 60cm Height   |
| <b>Planting:</b>                   | Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.  |
| <b>Fertilizing &amp; Watering:</b> | Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.  |
