

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Michelia	Michelia Figo (Port Wine Magnolia)
Description:	An evergreen, rounded shrub or small tree with glossy green, oval leaves. Richly fragrant, brownish-purple flowers are borne in spring and summer. The rich fragrance of the flowers makes this shrub a useful addition to any garden.
Planting Position:	Prefers a moist, humus rich, well draining soil. Thrives in a sunny to partly shaded position protected from frost. Pruning will produce new flowering growth. Water well in summer. Temperature Range 7° to 37°
Plant Size (approx):	2m high x 2m wide
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
