

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Murraya	Murraya Paniculata (Orange Jessamine)
Description:	An evergreen, rounded shrub with rich green aromatic foliage. During summer it bears a mass of highly perfumed, white flowers. Several flushes of flowers may occur during the year.
Planting Position:	Suitable as a screen or hedge. Prefers a rich, moist well draining soil rich in organic matter. Thrives in a sunny to partly shaded position. Responds to pruning and trimming. Temperature Range 2° to 37°
Plant Size (approx):	3m high x 3m wide
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
