PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Palm	Chamaedorea Atrovirens (Cascade Palm)
Description:	Low growing attractive trunkless Mexican palm which splits and separates to form two growths which slowly develop into spreading clumps. Each crown has up to six upright to arching pinnate leaves.
Planting Position:	Prefers part shade warm position in garden or filtered light indoors, in well drained soil. Temperature Range: 8° to 35°
Plant Size (approx):	Up to 2m high
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Keep moist but not wet in the growing season and drier in winter and liquid fertilize in growing season to maintain lush growth.
