| Product Group: Fern | Platycerium Bifurcatum (Elkhorn Fern) |
| Description: | The magnificent elkhorn fern has broad, shield-shaped fronds from which emerge upright forked fronds. Plantlets grow from the base of the shield, resulting in large clumps. Best displayed attached to trees or timber backing. |
| Planting Position: | Prefers cool, moist, shade conditions. Temperature Range: 4° to 35° |
| Plant Size (approx): | Can grow up to 1m x 1m wide |
| Planting: | Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly. |
| Fertilizing & Watering: | Slightly drier in cold winter weather. Keep moist in the drier, hotter months. Liquid fertilize twice a year but half strength as can damage fronds if too strong. |
