

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Rosemary	Rosemary Tuscan Blue (Rosemarinus Officinalis)
Description:	A popular and very attractive evergreen small shrub which carries a profusion of rich blue flowers during spring and summer. The aromatic leaves are widely used for flavouring lamb, pork and poultry dishes.
Planting Position:	Prefers a well draining soil rich in organic matter. Thrives in a sunny to partly shaded position. Prune as desired. Temperature Range 2° to 40°
Plant Size (approx):	1.5m high x 1.5m wide
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
