

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Succulent	Sansevieria Nolinoideae Mother in Law's Tongue
Description:	Unusual plant with stiff, fleshy, leaves that are marked with interesting patterns. Great clumping plant when planted in gardens.
Planting Position:	Requires a very well drained soil in a part shade warm position free from frosts and cold weather. They are ideal for use in large tubs, arid garden beds, dry rock embankments, perfectly at home in cottage gardens and make ideal indoor specimen. Temperature Range: 8° to 40°
Plant Size (approx):	20 - 60cm high – clumping if planted in ground
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize with a good quality liquid plant food two or three times a year. Will tolerate short periods of dryness. Water only when dry.
