

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

Product Group: Syzygium	Syzygium Australe Orange Form
Description:	An evergreen tree with glossy dark green leaves and orange tinted new foliage. Fluffy white flowers are produced in summer and are followed by bright coloured berries in autumn. Flowers and fruit attract native birds.
Planting Position:	Perfect for hedging or screening. Prefers a well draining soil rich in organic matter. Thrives in a sunny to partly shaded position. Will tolerate frost once established. Temperature Range: 3°C to 37°C
Plant Size (approx):	Up to 10m high x 5m wide
Planting:	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
Fertilizing & Watering:	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
