

## PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

<b>Product Group:</b> Viburnum	<b>Viburnum Tinus Laurustinus</b>
<b>Description:</b>	A rounded evergreen shrub with oval, dark green, glossy leaves which develop purplish tones in colder weather. During winter it bears tight clusters of tiny, white flowers which emerge from pink buds and these are followed by blue-black berries.
<b>Planting Position:</b>	Great for screening plant or hedge. Grows well in full sun and part shade. Moderately frost hardy. Needs a well drained position. Temperature Range 2° to 40°
<b>Plant Size (approx):</b>	3m high x 3m wide
<b>Planting:</b>	Dig a hole approximately twice the size of the container. Remove plant and place into the hole so the soil level is the same as the surrounding ground. Fill in the hole and push down firmly and water in thoroughly.
<b>Fertilizing &amp; Watering:</b>	Fertilize in spring with a slow release fertilizer and water to keep moist in a pot situation.
